

RE: Boat Ramp and Pier Marine Contractor Use

This letter is to update residents on the process for Marine Contractors and their use of the SAIA boat ramp and pier working for SAIA residents. SAIA's existing rules state the following:

SAIA residents must be current members and have purchased a current boat ramp key.

"The ramp may not be used for any commercial purpose, nor may permit-holders employ any commercial enterprise to use it without SAIA permission."

"A permit holder may allow a hired agent to use the permit if

i) the use is for the benefit of the permit holder, and

ii) the Association approves in advance."

To control the use of our boat ramp with unauthorized Marine Contractors, we have initiated the following formal process to protect the ramp and pier:

A Contractor Ramp Use Form on the SAIA website must be filled out by the contractor and submitted to the SAIA Ramp Master Board Member. The form can be downloaded here: (add link to website)

- The contractor and the SAIA resident must meet all criteria on the form to be approved and authorized. Use of the boat ramp and community pier can start once the form has been approved.
- The contractor must be working for a SAIA member.
- The contractor must be licensed and insured.
- There is a \$250 form fee that must be paid prior to the work start date.
- The ramp key must be returned to the SAIA resident once the project has been completed.
- The contractor must carry the form to show proof of authorization.

Violation of these terms will result in revocation of SAIA boat ramp privileges by the SAIS for the member and contractor. SAIA will bring criminal trespassing charges against any contractors that violate these rules.
